

7th-12th June 2016: MODENA CENTO ORE IS READY TO GO

A unique event, both in Italy and in the world.

For 2016, the organisers have prepared yet another special edition, a 'Coast to Coast' that will cross Italy from east to west, from the Adriatic to the Tyrrhenian Sea.

The **2016 edition of Modena Cento Ore**, organised by **Scuderia Tricolore** of Reggio Emilia, is ready to start. From **June 7th to 12th**, 90 wonderful classic cars will challenge each other on roads and racetracks from Emilia Romagna to Toscana, from **Rimini** to **Firenze**, and finally from **Forte dei Marmi** to **Modena**. Three races on the legendary tracks of **Imola**, **Misano** and **Mugello**, and 12 special stages on roads closed to the public.

Luigi Orlandini, Chairman of the Organising Committee and ingenious founder of Canossa Events, tells us the highlights of this edition: "Modena Cento Ore has established itself as one of the most important races in the world, and as a gathering place for the biggest names in this business. This has been proven by our nomination at the International Historic Motoring Awards, the 'Oscars' of historic motoring.

This year we wanted to create a special edition by transforming the event into an exciting 'Coast to Coast' challenge. The race is quite tough, and includes **12 special stages** and **3 circuit races** with starting grids in **Imola**, **Misano** and **Mugello**. Furthermore, many gentlemen drivers will bring their most prized vehicles: let's just say that the total value of this year's cars is over 100 million euros, according to an expert!

Modena Cento Ore is not just a race. It also offers the unique opportunity to drive veritable pieces of art through the picture postcard-worthy landscapes of Toscana and Emilia-Romagna.

Then there are also its evenings, created to let the participants – mostly foreigners – discover special locations and the fine cuisine of our country, and also our attention to safety and the environment. Indeed, this is the only 'zero-emission' grand event in the industry.

More importantly, the Cento Ore is about passion, sport and friendship!"

The programme

As always, spectators are more than welcome at Modena Cento Ore, even at the racetracks where the crews will challenge each other.

As announced, the race starts on **June 8th** at 9:00 in the morning with the circuit race at the **Imola Racetrack**, and then continues with the special stages at the Sambuca and Brisighella-Modigliana passes. Lunch will be held in Palazzuolo sul Senio, and the leg will end in **Piazza Cavour, Rimini** around 18:45 with the arrival of the first cars.

The second leg will start on **June 9th** at 8:30 with a race at the **Misano World Circuit** Marco Simoncelli, followed by the special stages at the Spino and Croce ai Mori passes. At the end of the day, the crews will arrive in the wonderful **Piazza Ognissanti** in **Firenze** at 17:00.

June 10th will start the same way at the **Mugello Racetrack** at 9:00, then the participants will reach Barga and the Garfagnana for the special stages of Tereglio and Renaio. This day will end with the Time Control in Piazza del Duomo, Pietrasanta at 18:00 and the leg arrival in Piazza Marconi, **Forte dei Marmi** at 18:30.

On **June 11th**, the fourth and final leg will start from Forte dei Marmi and, after crossing the Apuan Alps and the Radici Pass, will feature firstly the Careggine and Massa-Sassorosso special stages, then the last one at the **Castle of Carpineti** and the finish in **Modena**.

It is right there, in Piazza Grande, that the public will have the opportunity to spectate the **final arrival** of the cars under the Ghirlandina. The first crews will arrive around **16:45** and the podium ceremony will start at 18:45.

Each day, the fatigue from driving is interrupted by moments of relaxation that go from the 'village fair' in the centre of Palazzuolo sul Senio to the deep spirituality of the Franciscan Sanctuary in Chiusi della Verna, from the elegant atmosphere of the Ciocco Resort to the traditional tastes of the Casone di Profecchia, a mountain refuge located near the Radici Pass, or also the themed welcome in Carpineti.

The programme is then completed by carefully planned evenings, each representing the cities that host this race: Rimini, Firenze, Forte dei Marmi and Modena.

Our Partners

The uniqueness of Modena Cento Ore is also possible thanks to the involvement of excellent partners such as Porsche and RM-Sotheby's, one of the world's leading auction houses in the classic car business, which has supported our event for years.

This year, other important brands will join the ranks of our partners: Straight Eighth Logistics, our official logistics partner, Cuervo y Sobrinos – which created a new automatic wristwatch for the occasion – and Blackfin, leading Italian eyewear manufacturer famous throughout the world for its titanium eyeglass frames.

Another recurring partner of the Cento Ore is the Panathlon Club of Modena. As usual, Scuderia Tricolore will make a donation **to support sports projects for disabled children**.

The organisers also confirm their care for the environment with the adoption of the CarbonZero protocol, which will completely offset the CO2 emissions with the planting of new trees in the Tosco-Emilian Apennines. Modena Cento Ore is the only 'zero-emission' event in this sector.

Once again, **the numbers of the Modena Cento Ore** are truly record-breaking:

- **90 cars**, a limit imposed by the Organiser to keep the event exclusive, in spite of the 200 applications received, for a total value of over **€ 100 million**.
- **18 countries** represented by **180** participants coming from all over the world: United Kingdom, Switzerland, Germany, France and other European countries, but also United States, Hong Kong, China...
- **Vehicles from 16 different car makers**, with a balance between Italian (Ferrari and Alfa Romeo), British (Jaguar, Cobra, Lotus...) and German (Porsche and BMW) brands.

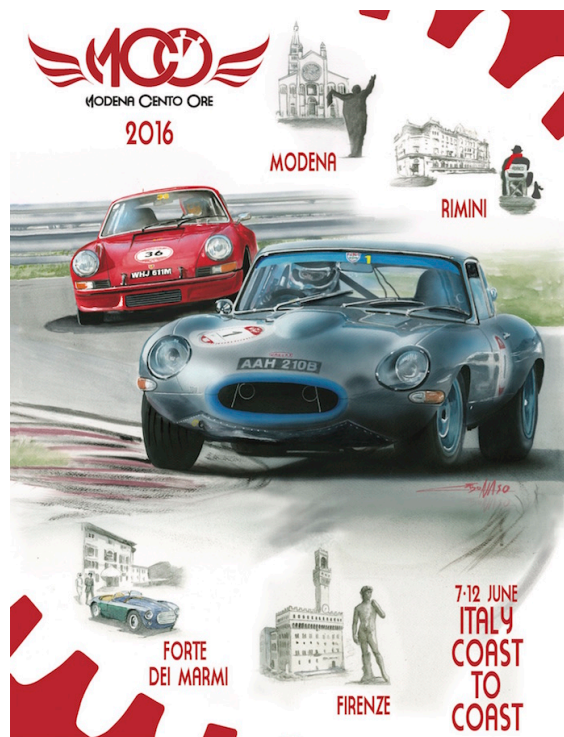


- **12 special stages** on closed roads, **3 circuit races**, 25 time checks, leg arrivals in 4 different cities
